- 4,000 international students** from **70 countries**;

- 800 + students** every year in joint programs.

Research and Innovation

- **Nearly CAD 46M** average annual research funding, for the past three years;
- **CAD 5,5M** in external funding for research and international projects;
- **70% +** of research activities are carried out in collaboration with industry;
- **78** research chairs, units, institutes and groups;
- **86 +** partner countries for scientific collaborations, including **56%** of international co-publications.
