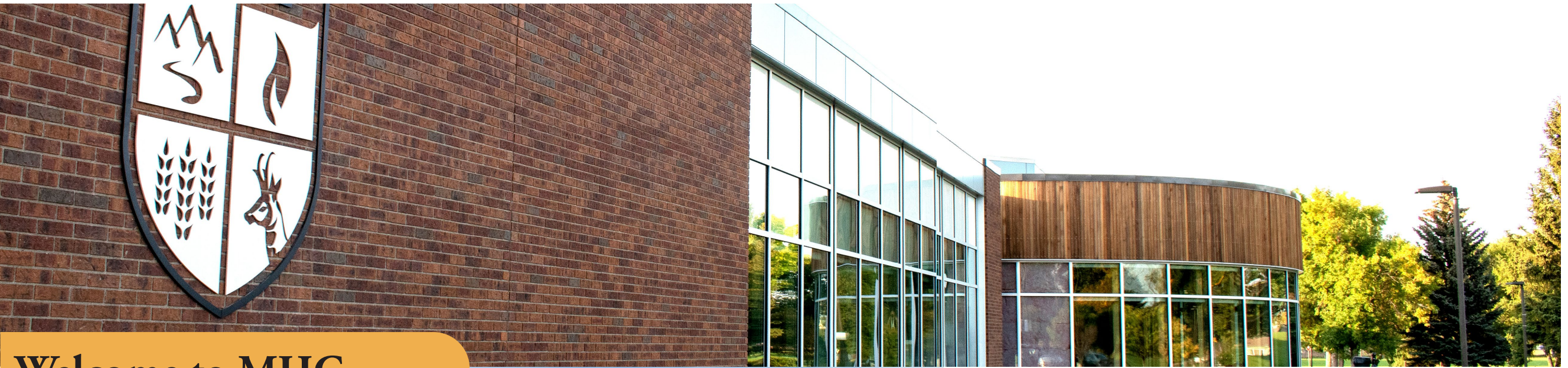

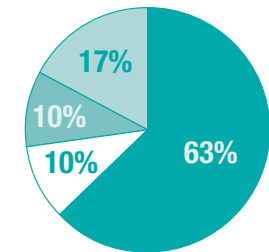

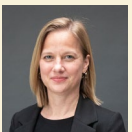
Medicine Hat College started in **1965** and will celebrate its 60th anniversary in 2025-2026

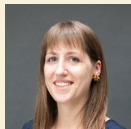
