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STATE OF GUANAJUATO

The State of Guanajuato is located in the heart of Mexico, known as El Bajío. The State is accessible and well-connected. It covers an area of 30,608 sq. km with 46 municipalities. Its automotive, agricultural, leather and footwear strong sectors are a sign of visionary and intensive work.

GUANAJUATO CITY

In 1988, Guanajuato city was declared World Heritage site by UNESCO. The architecture and the decorative elements of baroque and neoclassical buildings of the city, such as the "Templo de la Compañía" a former Jesuit church, and the Valenciana church, are considered among the most beautiful examples of the baroque architecture.

Guanajuato city has become a model of traditional colonial architecture, and offers to visitors a highly creative city layout, among any other surprises. Today, though gold production may be minimal, the city still ranks among the world's top silver producers.

The cultural project of the University of Guanajuato (UG) is a regional, national, and international reference and is one of the broadest in the state, with the most diverse range of cultural and artistic expressions. University of Guanajuato's International Book Fair (FILUG), has been held since 1958, promoting literature and all artistic and academic manifestations.

The network of Museums and Art Galleries of the University of Guanajuato has attractive proposals with the permanent collection of the university's cultural heritage and the temporary exhibitions.

The UG Cinema Club is an alternative forum for film exhibition and knowledge.

The Folkloric Ballet (BAFUG) with more than 40 years of history, with scenic and recreational choreographic productions based on research to learn, preserve, and sustain the traditions of the state of Guanajuato and Mexico.

With more than 60 years of history, the UG Cinema Club, had produced



perfect space for international film festivals, enabling the expansion of the community's imagination.

The Cátedra Cervantina serves as a hub for interdisciplinary collaboration, bringing together research leaders, professors, and students in dynamic exchanges. Its mission revolves around the preservation and advancement of UG's cultural legacy, centered on the iconic figure of Miguel de Cervantes Saavedra.

The International Cervantes Festival, popularly known as "El Cervantino", takes place each fall in Guanajuato City. Dates to the mid-20th century, it traces back to the performance of short plays by Miguel de Cervantes, known as "entremeses", in the city's plazas and serves as the backdrop for this renowned event.

The university radio station, "Radio Universidad (XEUG)", has emerged as a cultural alternative. Broadcasting content 24 hours a day, Radio UG offers a diverse range of programs.

"Day of the Dead" is celebrated as a compendium of artistic, academic and recreational activities around the festivity. The Symphonic Orchestra (OSUG) holds a prestigious position as one of the premier orchestras in Latin America. With a rich history and esteemed

reputation, it stands as one of the oldest and well respected orchestral ensembles in Mexico.

Espiral Foro Universitario is a platform for students of the UG, and promotes artistic expression in various disciplines such as dance, drama, music, visual arts and literature of the university community.

The University Theater Company, the Choir, the *Estudiantina*, the *Rondalla Santa Fe*, the *Rondalla Señorial*, and *Danza Contemporánea Génesis* are all part of the artistic talent fostered by the University.
