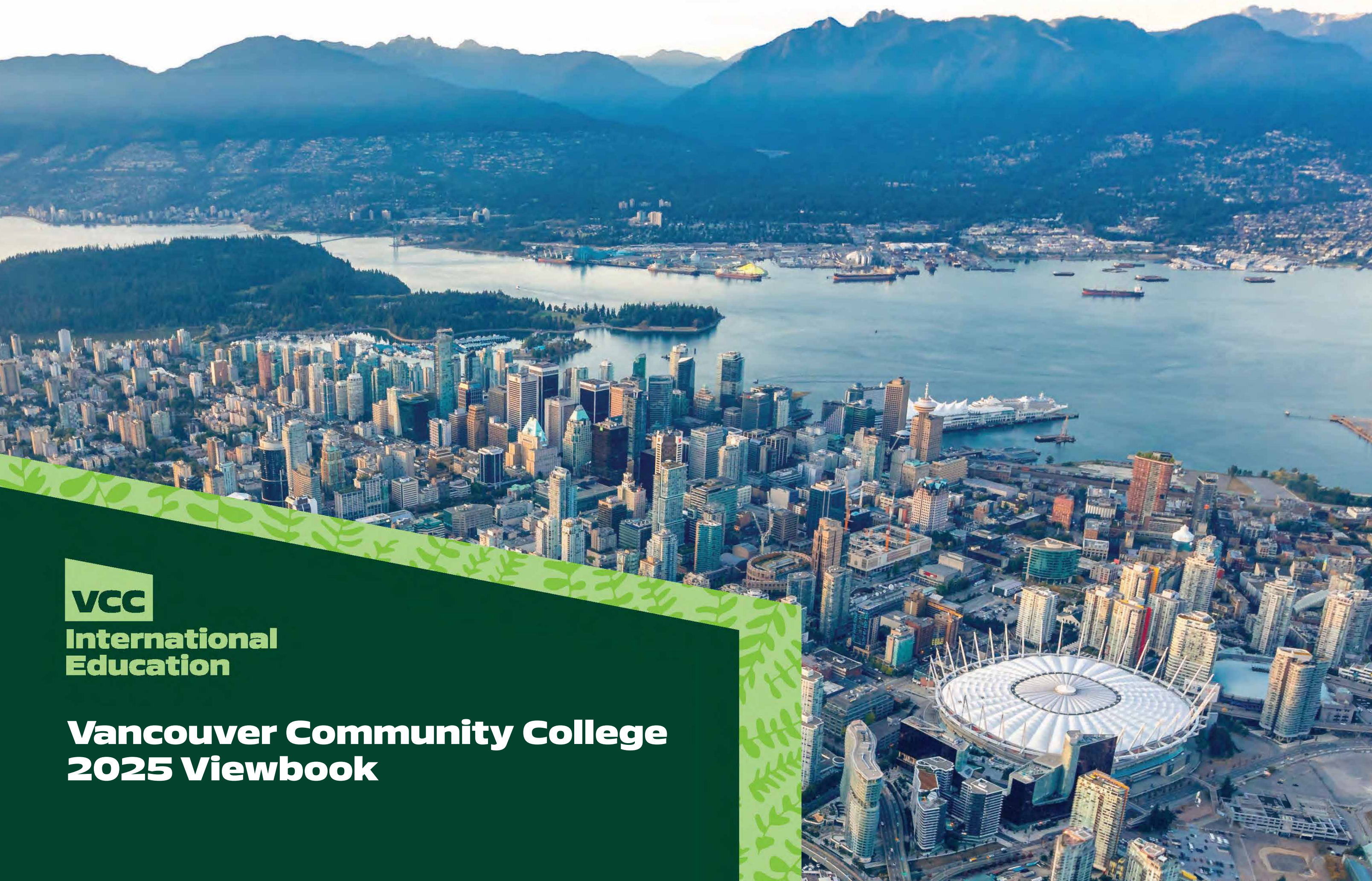

Global experiences, partnerships, and mobility

A key strategic objective of the IESP is to develop and enhance opportunities for the VCC community to participate in and benefit from global engagement through strategic partnerships and internationalization at home.

A shining example of such a partnership was highlighted during a visit by VCC delegates to the Coast Institute of Technology (CIT) in Voi, Kenya, as part of the Young Africa Works project, sponsored by Colleges and Institutes Canada (CiCan) and funded by the Mastercard Foundation.

This visit provided a chance to deepen collaboration between the institutions and enhance CIT's capabilities in curriculum development, instruction, and evaluation.

UMAP International Secretariat

In January 2021, VCC began a five-year term representing Canada as International Secretariat (IS) of University Mobility in Asia and the Pacific (UMAP), a voluntary association of government and non-government representatives of the higher education sector.

As the UMAP IS, VCC will oversee administration and programming for the consortium. Working in close collaboration with the chairperson of UMAP and the National Secretariat for Canada, along with the National Secretariats of member countries, VCC will manage various study abroad programs, facilitate joint research projects among faculty members from different member universities, and convene bi-annual international board meetings.
